DESIGN INITIATIVES/ACTIONS UNDERTAKEN

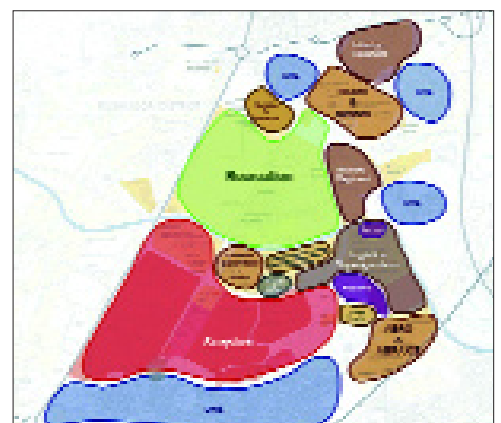
Allenby Connaught was a proposal to redevelop the barracks at seven MOD sites in the Salisbury Plain area as part of the Private Finance Initiative.

Battle McCarthy was commissioned as Sustainable Development Advisor for all seven sites. Our role involved providing input on sustainability for the production of the Environmental Impact Assessments for each site.

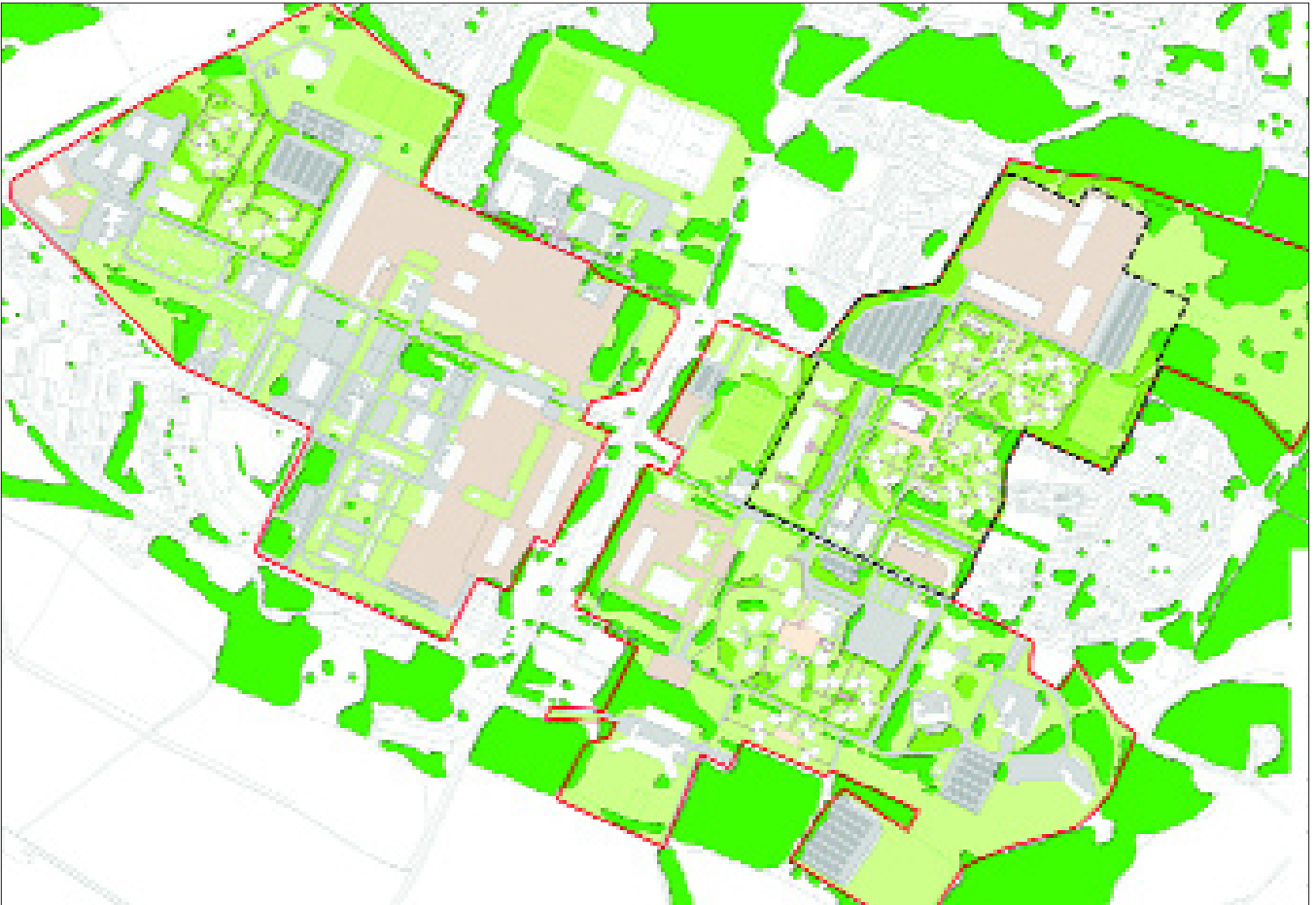
In addition, a separate sustainability statement was produced for each site to accompany the planning application that explained how social, economic and environmental issues had been addressed within the masterplan; the issues that were relevant to the EIAs; and the plans for future monitoring and review of sustainable development.

The sites were particularly sensitive given their proximity to Salisbury Plain (nature conservation value) and Stonehenge (World Heritage Site).

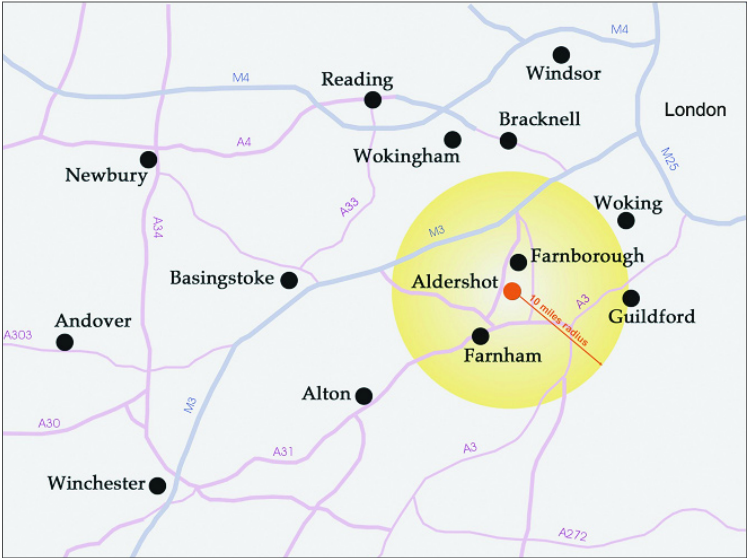


Overall Concept
